Worldwide, Universal—Wa-Klo Alumni have been very busy!!

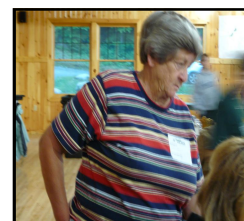
